BITCOIN ATM SCAMS ALERT

WHAT IS HAPPENING?

Fraudsters are increasingly using Bitcoin ATMs to scam victims. Scammers impersonate government officials, banks, or police and pressure people to withdraw cash and deposit into a Bitcoin ATM.



HOW THE SCAM WORKS:

- Spoofed call: You receive a call pretending to be from CRA, ICBC, police or a bank.
- Urgent threats: They claim you owe money or face arrest.
- **Cash withdrawal:** They instruct you to withdraw cash from your bank.
- Bitcoin ATM deposit: They send a QR code and coach you to deposit money into their Bitcoin wallet stealing your funds!

RED FLAGS TO WATCH OUT FOR:

- Pressure to act immediately
- Requests for payment through
 Bitcoin ATMs, e-transfers or gift cards
- Complex jargon or technical language

HOW TO STAY SAFE:


- ✓ Never share personal information
- ✓ Never make payments via Bitcoin ATMs
- ✓ Do your research and use only reputable cryptocurrency

HOW TO REPORT IF YOU ARE A VICTIM OF THIS SCAM:

- Contact your local police department to make a report.
- Report it to your bank and/or credit card company as soon as possible.
- Call the Canadian Anti-Fraud Centre: 1-888-495-8501 to report.
- Monitor your credit score through Equifax Canada or Transunion Canada.

HOW TO STOP CAR THIEVES: 5 SMART TIPS TO PROTECT YOUR VEHICLE

Vehicle theft is a major issue in British Columbia, with around **6,900 cars stolen annually**. The financial and emotional impact on victims is significant, but many thefts can be prevented with a few simple steps.



Car theft can happen in various ways, from opportunistic thieves taking advantage of unlocked doors or running engines to organized rings targeting specific vehicles. Thefts often occur quickly, in less than a minute, and in places we consider safe, like driveways or parking lots.

While modern cars come with anti-theft features like immobilizers and GPS tracking, no system is foolproof. Thieves continue to find ways around these technologies, so experts recommend a layered security approach. This includes combining technology, physical deterrents, and good habits.

Understanding where and how thefts happen is key. Thieves often target cars that are easy to access—unlocked, running, or in poorly lit areas—and sometimes don't even need to break in, just taking advantage of keys left inside.



VEHICLE PROTECTION CHECKLIST

■ Lock Doors & Close Window - Check that all doors are locked and windows are fully closed before leaving your car.	
☐ Never Leave Keys In them in the car, ever	side - Always take your keys with you—never leave for a moment.
	□ Park in Well-Lit Areas - Choose secure, well-lit spots with high foot traffic or near security cameras.
	☐ Use a Steering Wheel Lock - Install a visible steering wheel lock to make your car a less appealing target.
	☐ Stay Alert - Be aware of your surroundings and report any suspicious activity to authorities.

By using these simple strategies together, you can significantly reduce the risk of theft and protect your vehicle.
